# OVERVIEW OF PROP 28

## Art Education

- California voters approved Proposition 28: The Arts and Music in Schools (AMS) Funding Guarantee and Accountability Act. The measure required the state to establish a new, ongoing program supporting arts instruction in schools beginning in 2023–24.

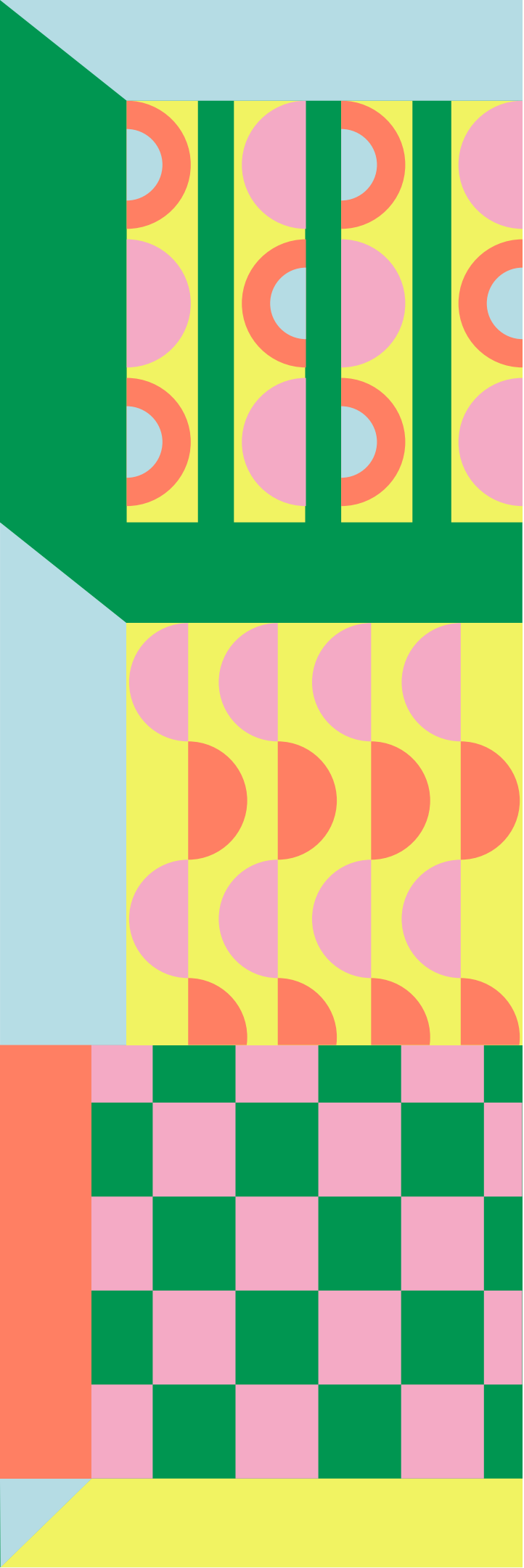
**Jack London: \$43,000**

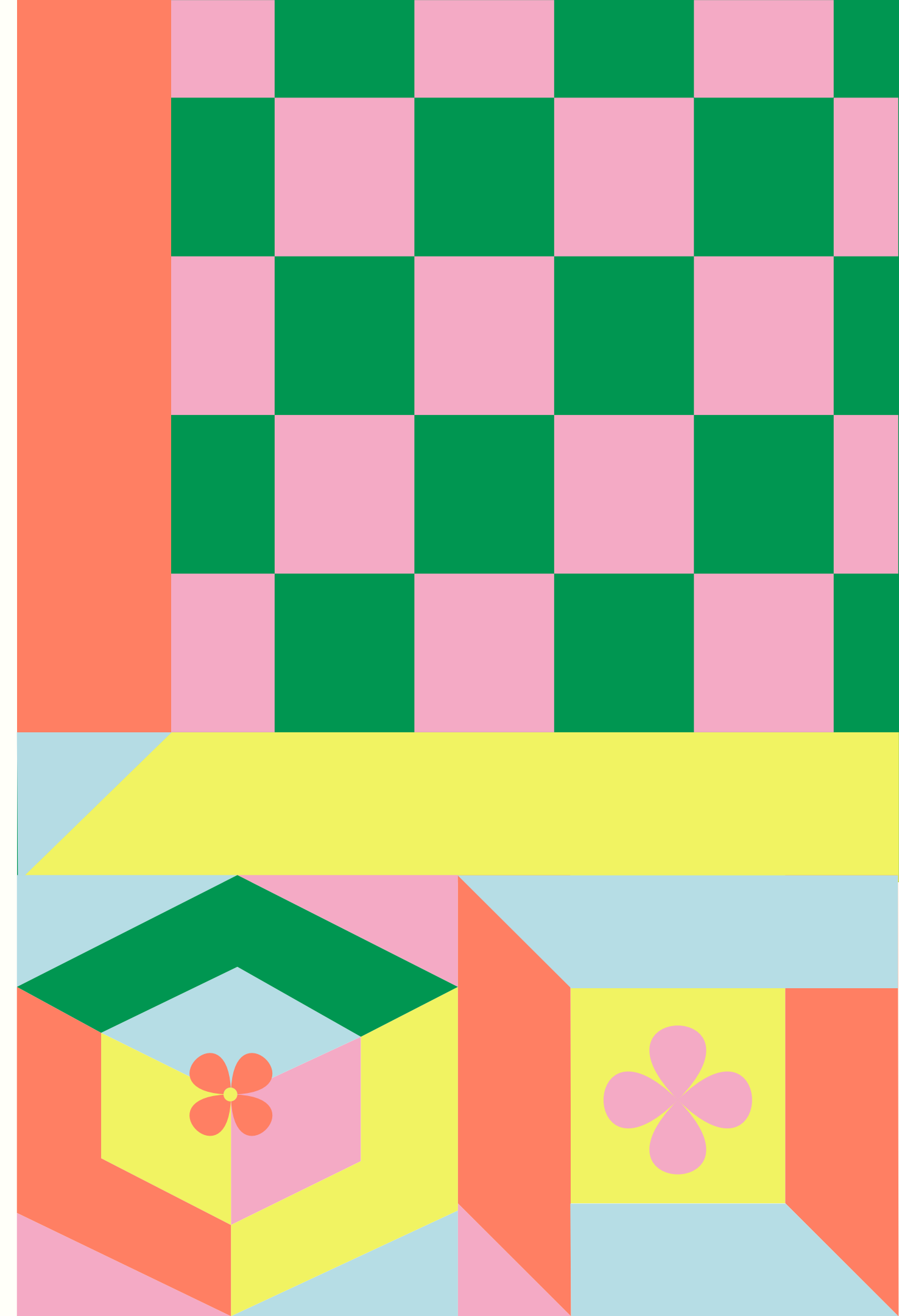

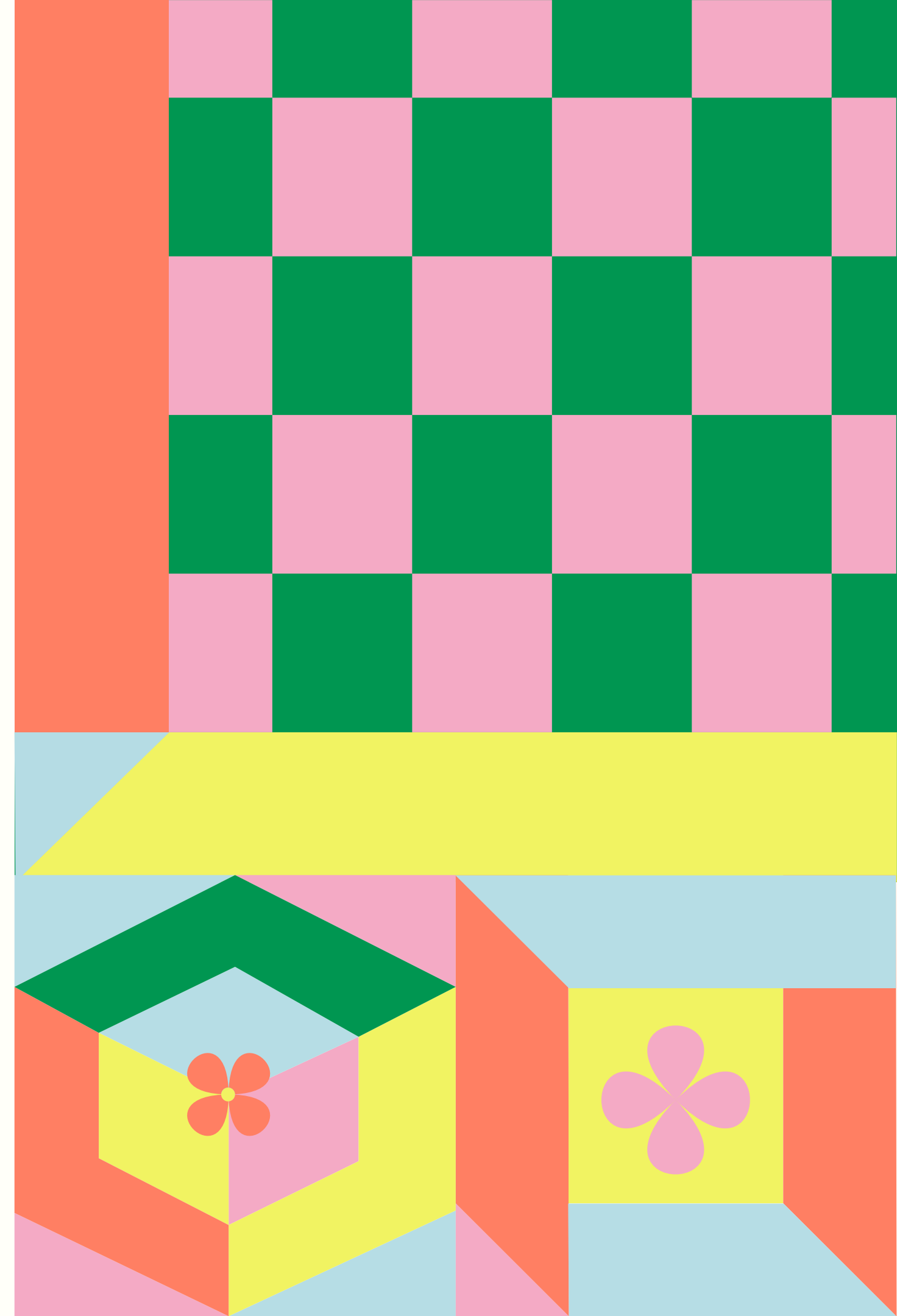

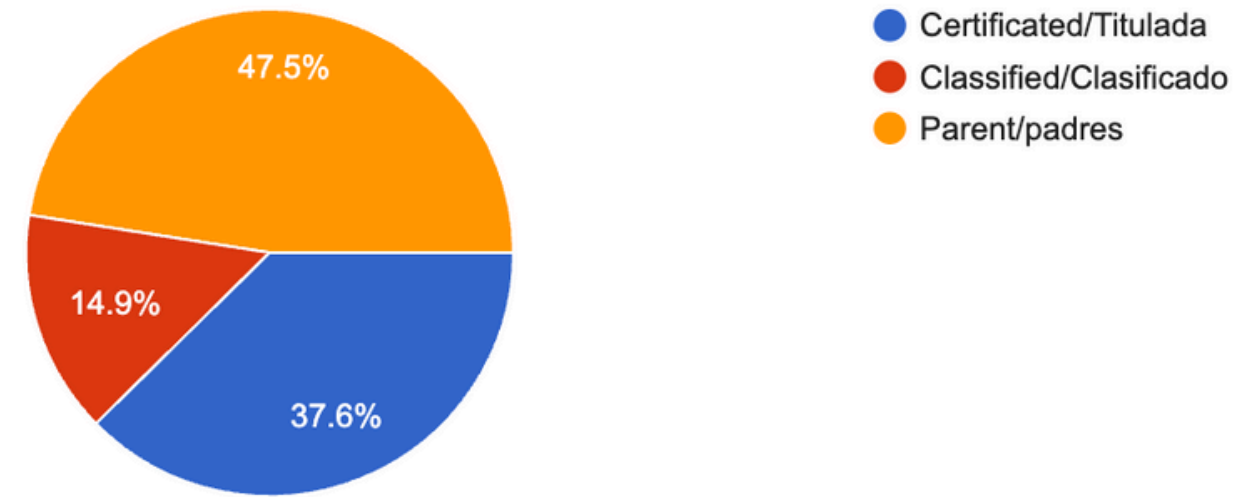

# WHO RESPONDED?

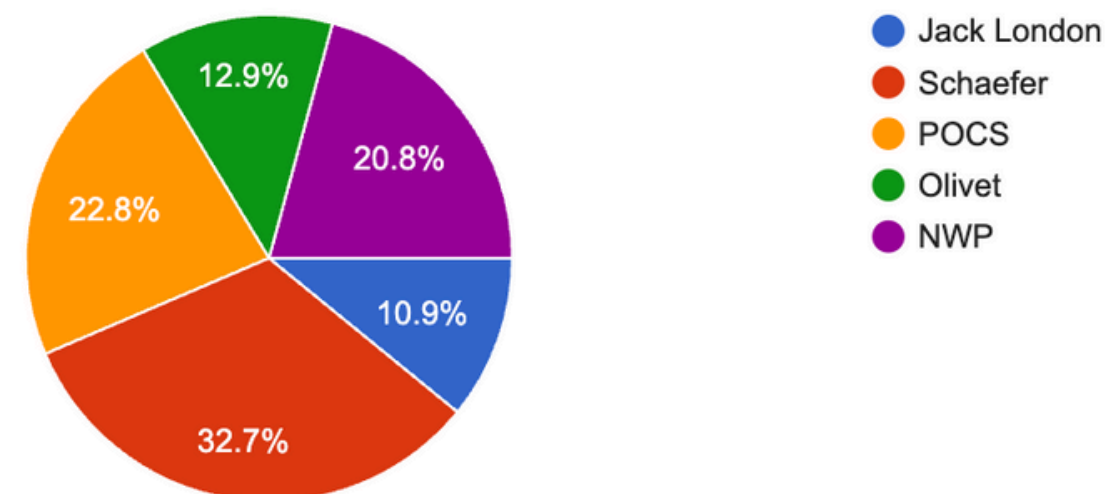

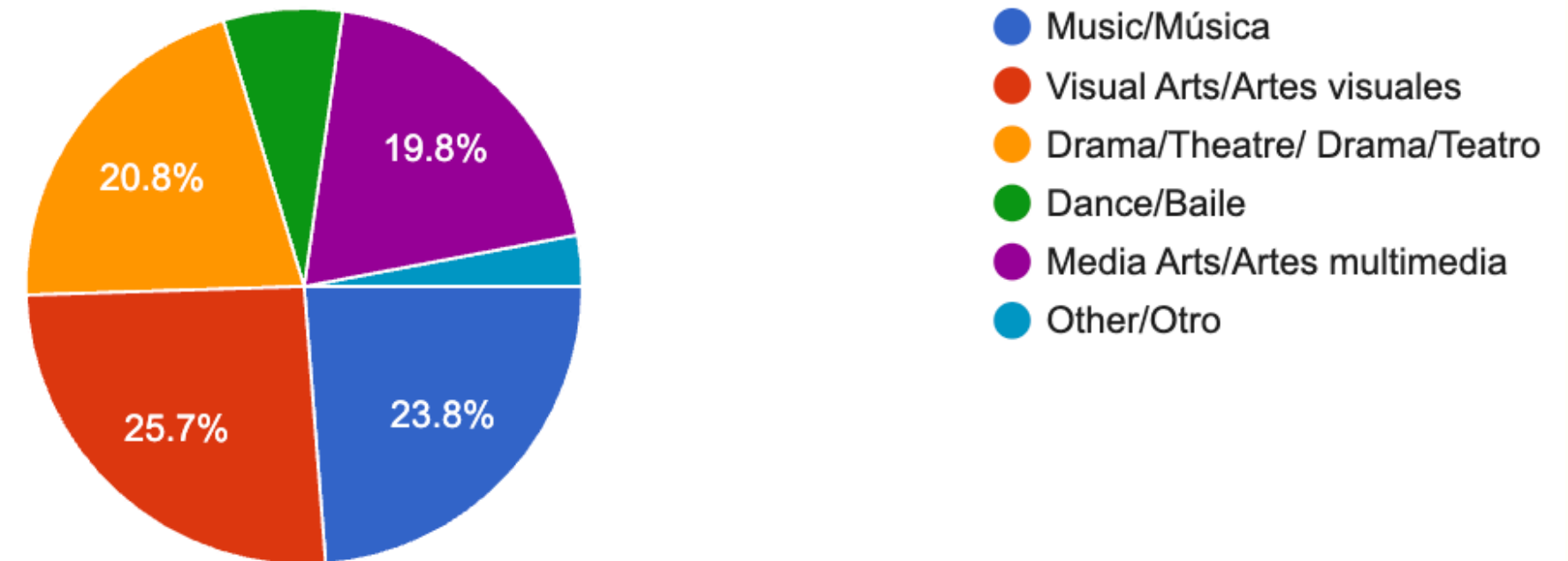




# WHAT PEOPLE SAID?

How would you like to see art implemented in our schools? / ¿Cómo le gustaría ver el arte implementado en nuestras escuelas?



  - Keep it Simple
  - Depends on Availability

# OUR DISTRICT PLAN
